Background

All organisations have a legal responsibility to manage their health and safety risks and ensure the safety, health and welfare of their employees and all others who may be affected by their activities. The loss of a key employee as a result of an accident can have major repercussions and accidents in the workplace are still a major cause for concern and physical injury may result in a civil claim, cause poor morale and/or prosecution by the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).

Summary

Where appropriate we will make recommendations for improvement and take photographs to highlight areas of concern, subject to your organisation's agreement.

The inspection will help your organisation to identify what it needs to do in a particular area or activity to make any necessary improvements to its health and safety management arrangements.

Objectives

The inspection will cover:

- Procedures and safe systems of work
- Attitudes to health and safety
- Risk assessments
- Training
- Work equipment and personal protective equipment
- Safety controls, inspection and monitoring
- Emergency procedures
- Electricity, COSHH and manual handling
- Health and safety of visitors and contractors.

Features

- Provision of a written report addressing the areas outlined above with supporting recommendations and guidance specific to the organisation
- The option to present the report to key representatives within the organisation to review and discuss the recommendations in more detail
- A review session can be arranged if required to assess the progress made, usually six to twelve months afterwards
